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Preface

A Word Before the Journey

I did not sit down to write a book of theory. Every law, every principle, and every revelation contained in these pages was first tested in the furnace of my own life before it was ever offered to you as a teaching. I have lived inside the chapters you are about to read. I have been processed by the same hand I describe in “*The Making of God*.” I have wrestled with gifts that were not what they appeared to be. I have had to settle the question of my own identity long before I ever settled the question of my assignment. So as you go through Apostolic Insight, understand that you are not merely reading my opinions; you are receiving the distilled residue of seasons I personally walked through, scriptures that became living realities inside of me, and wisdom that was extracted at great cost.

We are living in a generation that is desperately hungry for results but strangely allergic to process. Everyone wants the harvest; very few are willing to submit to the planting, the watering, and the pruning that precede it. This volume exists to correct that imbalance. It is a call back to divine order—to the understanding that God will always show you, then make you, before He ever blesses you, and that no man can legitimately bypass that sequence and expect a sustainable inheritance.

Within these pages, you will encounter nineteen distinct insights, each one a window into a different room of the same

mansion. We will examine why testing always precedes promotion, and why some of the gifts extended to you are designed to manipulate rather than to bless. We will explore the supremacy of identity over activity, the four levels of relationship every leader must master, and the ancient instruction of the number three that has quietly governed my own decisions for years. We will look at perspective, wisdom, human capital, and the mystery of how God moves the hearts of strangers on our behalf long before we ever meet them. We will study visibility, progress, the future, the storms that clear our path, and the routines that secretly write the story of our lives. We will sit at the feet of a pencil and let it teach us submission, sharpening, redemption, substance, and legacy. And we will close by examining the sacred transference of spirit and mantle that happens when a believer rightly identifies and consistently feeds upon the voice God has assigned to lead them.

None of this is offered to you as abstract theology. It is offered as a working manual—principles I have tested, scriptures I have stood on in seasons of fear and pressure, and laws I have watched operate with unfailing consistency in my own life and in the lives of those I have had the privilege of leading. My prayer is that as you read, the same Spirit that breathed these truths into me will breathe them into you, and that you will not close this book the same person who opened it.

This is Volume One of *Apostolic Insight*. Receive it with an open heart, a teachable spirit, and a readiness to be made before you are blessed.

THE MAKING OF GOD

How God Builds Us

God has a perfect, unchanging way of working in our lives. It is important to understand that God shapes your character before He ever truly expands your life. The process of being shaped will always come before the blessing. Within this journey, the one thing you can never avoid is testing. Anyone who is being built by God will inevitably be tried. God will always test you. He will thoroughly examine your patience, your perseverance, your consistency, your sincerity, your integrity, and your loyalty. These tests are essential as God develops you. It is only when you have successfully passed the test that He releases the blessing that matches your growth.

The Law of Promotion

This spiritual truth is perfectly mirrored in our physical world. In school, a student is never promoted until they take and pass an exam. You must prove that you have mastered your current level before you can move to the next stage. The exact same principle applies to your life. Your character will always be tested, and

passing that test is what qualifies you to step out of your current state and into the next phase of your destiny. Owing to this, stay aware of the changing circumstances and sudden situations in your life—they may very well be your divine exam. Certain intense pressures that feel completely unbearable are often not sent by the enemy to destroy you; instead, they are allowed by God to test you and bring out your best.

God Equips You Before He Tests You

There are foundational lessons you must learn before you can ever be tested. God is too faithful to let you walk into a situation that He hasn't already trained you to handle. If He allows you to go through a difficult trial with immense pressure, you can rest assured that He has already equipped you ahead of time. He may have shown you the life stories of mature believers who went before you, allowing you to see how they successfully handled pressure. He may have guided you to listen to a specific message or read books that gave you the exact knowledge and wisdom you need for this moment. Therefore, when a test comes, God expects you to use what you have been taught so that your character can be proven.

Watch Your Words During the Test

Sadly, many people forget the lessons they learned and the spiritual growth they received, causing them to fail their season of testing. When this happens, they often speak careless words that disrupt the very things God is building in their lives. The primary way you pass any trial in life is through your words. If the words coming out of your mouth contradict God's plan for your future, you end up tearing down what He is trying to construct.

- **The Secret of Joy:** You have likely heard testimonies of believers who went through terrible trials and overcame them through the joy of the Lord. You access that divine joy by singing praises, shifting your focus, and genuinely thanking God for everything He has already done.
- **The Example of Job:** You have heard how Job blessed the name of the Lord even after losing everything. These are practical examples you have been taught.

No matter what happens to you, your assignment is to remember those lessons and apply them so that your faith can be proven true.

Guarding Your Mind and Your Words

Unfortunately, many people fail during seasons of testing. When God is building your character, He allows difficult things to happen. However, just because trouble knocks on your door does not mean God has abandoned or dislikes you. In fact, standing right in the middle of God's will often attracts specific challenges into your life. When you are exactly where God wants you to be and trouble comes, its purpose is not to destroy you, but to make you unstoppable. Whatever confronts you is designed to make you strong. The secret lies in how you manage your inner world. When you face the storms of life, there are two distinct gates you must guard carefully: the way you think and the way you talk.

1. Guard Your Thoughts

You must refuse to dwell on the lie that defeat has won. Entertaining thoughts of failure secretly turns them into reality. A negative circumstance hasn't truly won until your mind agrees to give up.

2. Guard Your Words

A problem cannot fully establish itself in your life until your mouth gives it permission through negative talk. If a difficult situation occurs but you boldly declare God's promises, you successfully take authority over that circumstance. Master this principle: stay highly aware of your thoughts and your speech in the middle of the battle. **The Pattern of Promotion: God will always train you in secret before He tests you in the open.** When you pass the exam, He promotes you to the next stage of your life. How you handle pressure matters. Stay spiritually aware of the tests that come your way. God will never give you a test until He has first taught you the lesson. Pay close attention to whatever you are learning right now, and learn from the experiences of others around you. That exact knowledge and wisdom are exactly what you will need to call upon when your time of testing arrives.

BEWARE OF GIFTS!

Being Wise with Gifts and Advice

You must understand that you should not accept every gift presented to you. By their very nature, certain gifts carry hidden motives. They are intentionally given to manipulate your future, control your possessions, and take away what God has placed in your hands. Because of this, you must live with deep spiritual discernment. Sometimes, this trap does not arrive wrapped as a physical present; instead, it comes disguised as advice. Certain counsel and guidance are offered as though they are meant to help you, yet they are fundamentally deceptive. You must look past the friendly presentation and see clearly into the true intent of the person's heart. More often than not, when people offer advice or material items, they are playing a long, calculated game to influence your future. If you blindly accept what they offer, you can unknowingly step directly into a trap.

Protecting What God Gave You

Many people have lost the spiritual callings and assignments God gave them simply because they accepted contaminated gifts

from others. Countless individuals have forfeited their blessings because they were easily swayed by material things. They lacked the inner discipline required to protect what the Lord gave them by boldly saying “**no**” to what another person offered.

Learning from Biblical Examples

To understand the weight of this truth, we must study the warnings left behind in Scripture. Consider the first man, Adam. God placed him in charge of the Garden of Eden and gave him full access to everything in it. Beyond material things, Adam enjoyed an intimate relationship with his Creator. He was the highest authority on earth, given the right by God to lead and care for the planet. Unfortunately, Adam lost everything simply because of what someone handed to him. His wife gave him the forbidden fruit from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, and he accepted it without thinking. Often, accepting what people offer you is a silent way of rejecting what God has already given you. You don’t have to say out loud, “***I am rejecting God’s provision.***” The moment you accept what is forbidden from human hands, you automatically step outside the boundaries of heaven.

The Danger of Compromise

Countless individuals have lost their spiritual inheritance because they lacked the character and discipline to say a firm “**no.**” This is exactly why many fall into sexual immorality. They give in to compromise simply because someone made themselves easily available, misinterpreting a spiritual trap as a convenient opportunity. As a result, they lose the calling God gave them, and many never recover the future they were meant to have.

The Cost of Compromise

Look at Samson. He lost his sight, his authority, and his respect because Delilah made herself easily available to him. He took the immediate opportunity, completely blind to the fact that his future was being destroyed. Many people have completely drained the spiritual strength God gave them because they were too easily swayed, lacked boundaries, and lacked the strength to say “**no**.” In fact, some of the deep conflicts thriving in our world today exist simply because of a single compromised decision made centuries ago. God had already promised Abraham that He would give him a son, Isaac, and make him the father of many nations. Yet, while waiting for the promise to arrive, human impatience set in. Sarah offered Abraham a shortcut by giving him her servant, Hagar. Abraham accepted this gift from his wife, and history is still dealing with the fallout of that unauthorized shortcut today.

The Trap of Past Generosity

On the account of this, you must be extremely cautious about what you accept from others—especially from those who do not share your faith or are spiritually immature.

- **The Strategy of Hidden Motives:** Some people give you gifts solely to manipulate your direction. They hand you things so they can quietly take control of what God has entrusted to you.
- **The Long Motive:** They invest in you intentionally, waiting for a future moment to make a massive demand on your life, ministry, or resources. They know that when that day comes, you will find it nearly impossible to say “**no**” because you feel indebted to their past generosity.

You must be exceptionally wise. Walk with deep discernment, continually trusting the Holy Spirit to guide your choices and protect your boundaries.

Maintaining Balance in Receiving Gifts

While you must protect your boundaries, wisdom requires you to handle these situations with grace. When an unauthorized gift, bad advice, or compromised suggestion comes your way, you must have a polite yet unshakeable way of saying “**no**.” If you fail to turn away these subtle intrusions, you end up compromising what God has placed in your hands. This is why you need deep spiritual discernment. You must learn to read the true intent behind a person’s actions.

Know When to Accept and When to Reject

You must maintain a healthy balance in your relationships:

- **When to Accept:** When people offer you gifts from a place of pure love, genuine honor, and a clean heart, you should receive them with gratitude.
- **When to Refuse:** The key is to stay highly sensitive to the Holy Spirit the moment a gift is offered. If you are careless, you can unknowingly hand over your assignment, ministry, or breakthrough to someone who is trying to control you with their wealth.

Draw a line in the sand and make up your mind right now: **not everything offered to you should be received**. Especially when you are going through a delicate season of growth, you must be careful about what you allow into your life. Certain packages are highly deceptive and are given solely to manipulate your

direction. As you step into the future God has for you, anchor your heart in patience, persistence, and spiritual strength.

PROCESS PRECEDES PROGRESS

The Pathway of Preparation

You must understand that preparation always comes before progress, and progress is what leads to true success. This sequence is not just a clever rhyme; it is a practical law of life. When you are on your path toward greater heights, you should expect to go through seasons of difficult trials. At times, you will encounter roadblocks—obstacles meant to block your path, or distractions designed to pull you away from your main assignment. Here is the vital reality you must grasp: **if you choose to persist and stay consistent, you will discover the exact steps needed to move forward.**

Staying Spiritually Alert

Throughout this season of growth, you must depend completely on God. Cry out to Him for direction and stay highly sensitive to the Holy Spirit. Learn to pay attention to and evaluate the thoughts, burdens, and insights that come to your heart during and after prayer. The Holy Spirit will give you perfect clarity. Sometimes, your guidance will come from the

Lord in unexpected ways: An Unexpected Word: You might be near a casual conversation and overhear a phrase, and suddenly, a quiet voice inside you confirms, **“This is the way; walk in it.”** Daily Awareness: **You must train yourself to stay spiritually alert, even in ordinary, everyday places, so you can catch the wisdom you need to apply to your life.**

Finding Answers in Casual Conversations

To show you how this works, about eight years ago, I was sitting with a friend when he began sharing a message he had heard from a well-known pastor. Before this moment, I had been praying intensely, trusting God for a specific breakthrough. What I didn't realize was that God's strategy wasn't to drop a miracle into my lap. Instead, He wanted to give me a specific piece of knowledge so I would know exactly what to do. The very moment my friend repeated the pastor's words, a light went on inside me. I instantly recognized those words as the exact answer to my prayers. The irony was that the person sharing the message hadn't even applied those principles to his own life. Yet, as he spoke, everything became clear to me. I immediately did exactly what those instructions said, and I got the precise result I was looking for. That single piece of applied wisdom was what finally carried me out of that difficult season.

Your Progress Today is Your Process Tomorrow

This is how growth works: **people overcome their trials because they connect with the right helpers, or because they receive and boldly apply wisdom from the Lord.** When they put these truths into action, they break out of their trials and move forward. As they progress, they begin to see real results. For some, this means financial success. For others, it means

expanding their influence, building organizations, or acquiring property. However, you must understand that spiritual growth never stops. The moment you step into a new level of success, that breakthrough eventually becomes the starting point for your next test. In other words, your progress today will become your process tomorrow. The high point you occupy right now—the very breakthrough you are celebrating—will eventually become a familiar place that you will pray to grow beyond later on.

The Cycle of Growth

It is amazing to watch people pray for a breakthrough, receive it, and celebrate their new reality with overwhelming joy. Yet, within a few years, a deep restlessness stirs within their hearts regarding the very things they thanked God for yesterday. *Why does this happen? Is it ingratitude? No!* It is simply because yesterday's progress has served its purpose. It has now become the foundation you must stand on to be lifted higher. Always remember that no matter what heights you reach, you will eventually face a new season of growth, because where you are right now is not your final destination.

How to Move to the Next Level

The way forward is to train yourself to recognize the steps required for your next season:

- **Recognize Key Relationships:** You must learn to instantly recognize the strategic people God sends into your life to help you grow.
- **Follow God's Guidance:** For some transitions, God will give you direct instructions through the Holy Spirit.

- **Keep Learning:** For other breakthroughs, you will need to actively seek out courses, specialized training, seminars, or books to gain the exact knowledge required to break through your current ceiling.

If something is currently stuck or failing in your life, comfort yourself with this truth: **you are not the first person to face this exact mountain.** Others have faced it, overcome it, and come out winning. Trust God completely to guide you to the exact resources and answers you need. You will surely outgrow this season, move forward, and step into the future God has for you.

Three Pillars of Human Ambition: Being, Doing, and Having

Three fundamental pillars drive everything we hope to achieve in life. Every person has a natural, deep desire to **be** something, to **do** something, and to **have** something. We all long to grow into a specific kind of person, accomplish meaningful work, and own things we can call our own. This threefold desire is woven into the human heart. For example, if you say, “***I want to travel***” or “***I want to build a house,***” your desires are focused on **doing**. In this context, building is an action. Everything in a person’s life journey—no matter their age or background—revolves around this three-part goal: becoming someone of substance, doing meaningful work, and owning tangible things. To “**have**” means to legally own possessions and property. The things you have given you the power of ownership.

The True Purpose of Education

Modern schools often only train people to **do** a job. By its true design, education should never be limited to teaching you a practical task. Its main job is to shape who you are **becoming**.

For example, once you discover that you are a natural advocate at heart, you then seek the specific education that gives you the technical skills to work as a lawyer. True education is simply a tool to give you the exact knowledge you need for your specific future. However, reality shows that the vast majority of people don't know who they are before they enter the classroom. Your identity must be firmly established first. If you fail to answer the question of who you are, you will inevitably pursue the wrong kind of education. You will spend years studying for a career that was never meant for your true path in life.

The Danger of a Misaligned Path

Look at the widespread frustration in the professional world today. Some people are uniquely wired to thrive in business, yet they chose a career in the arts because they were swayed by peer pressure or poor advice. Others are natural counselors, yet their parents forced them into aviation school just to boast about having a pilot in the family. As a result, these individuals lack any true sense of fulfillment. Parents must prioritize helping their children discover who they really are before rushing them into a university course. Without a clear sense of identity, choosing the wrong path is inevitable. For instance, some who were born to be master architects are pushed into law school simply to satisfy their parents' expectations. Knowing who you are must come first, because a clear understanding of your identity tells you exactly what kind of knowledge you need to pursue.

Taking Charge of Your Learning

We need to rethink the true purpose of education. This doesn't mean education should be taken lightly. On the contrary, everyone must commit to continuous learning, whether inside

or outside a classroom. Being educated is non-negotiable. If you haven't had the opportunity to earn a formal degree, you must take charge of your own growth through self-education. You can do this by:

- **Reading Transformational Books:** Constantly feeding your mind with practical wisdom.
- **Seeking High-Level Information:** Learning from mentors, audio messages, and valuable resources.

Building this foundation of self-taught skill can elevate you to a place where you can start working, earning an income, and eventually paying for your own formal college education if you choose to.

The Trap of Having Without Becoming

We live in a world that is obsessed with **having**. People try to skip “**being**” and “**doing**” completely, jumping straight to **wealth and possessions**. You will find individuals who are doing absolutely nothing with their lives, yet they daydream about building mansions, owning luxury cars, flying in private jets, and traveling the world. Someone who is inconsistent, lazy, and wasting hours on the internet with visionless friends will still boldly declare that they want to be incredibly wealthy. This is a delusion—it is a dream that can never come true. You must commit your mind and hands to doing something practical and honest. You cannot enjoy the harvest of **having** if you skip the growth of **becoming** and the hard work of **doing**. So, what is the right way to build your life? What is the real structure we need to put in place to fix this mistake?

Why “Being” Must Come Before “Doing”

The foundational truth you must settle is this: **you must first become a person of character and substance.** Your immediate focus must be entirely on who you are meant to be. Once you have a clear understanding of your identity, you can naturally move into what you are called to do. It is through your purposeful work that you generate wealth and enjoy the rewards of what you have. The right order never changes: **identity comes before activity, and activity comes before prosperity.**

The Danger of Rushing into Action

Many people find themselves trapped in a cycle of endless, busy activity with very little real progress. This frustration happens because they rushed into **doing** without ever settling who they are **being**. They are making the mistake of trying to perform before they have been properly formed. When you skip the process of defining your true identity, you will eventually reach a dangerous point where you believe you should do everything simply because you are capable of doing many things. This is the exact trap that keeps multi-talented people frustrated and confused. They are overwhelmed by too many choices because they lack the clear sense of identity needed to separate their general talents from their specific life assignment.

Learning from My Own Experience

By nature, I love variety, exploring new ideas, and reading deeply. Because of this natural curiosity, there was a season in my life where I genuinely felt I could be a lawyer. At another point, I thought my path was in mass communication. There was even a time when I believed I was meant to be a school teacher and later a university lecturer. I was simply trying to reach for

everything all at once. However, a critical moment came when I realized I desperately needed to answer one question: **Who am I really meant to be?** Through prayer and self-discovery, I uncovered that my true calling was for ministry. Yet, even after that became clear, my mind still tried to wander. At times I wanted to jump into the corporate world, and at other times, I felt the pull to become a secular business owner.

The Law of Focus

It is entirely possible to understand and have insight into many different fields. But you must remember this fundamental rule: **you can know many things, but you cannot become many things.** Once you settle who you are meant to be, it becomes remarkably easy to identify what you are meant to do. You are wired to master a specific assignment, not to waste your energy across a thousand different distractions. Settle your identity before you rush into action, and you will finally have real success to show for your hard work.

The Power of Saying “No”

There are numerous projects, businesses, and opportunities that I deliberately shut down simply because they did not align with who I know myself to be. The moment I discovered my true identity, I instantly recognized my real assignment. More importantly, I also realized what I had no business doing. It is impossible to know what you should decline until you know who you are. When you clearly know who you are meant to be, you automatically discover who you are not meant to be. Remember: **your identity dictates your activity, and your activity commands your success.** The abundance you are meant to have will only match your life when who you are and what

you do are in perfect alignment. Therefore, if you are going to invest in any form of learning right now, let your primary focus be discovering your identity. Find your calling first, and then learn the skills needed to do the work. A student who wants to be a pilot doesn't wander into a law library; they go straight to an aviation academy. Knowing who you are will tell you exactly where you belong and where you do not fit. It will guide your friendships, choose your environment, and filter the very words you speak.

Anchoring Your Identity

I have settled my identity as a minister of God. Because that foundation is secure, I clearly understand the things I must do and the things I must strictly avoid. My identity and my assignment will always naturally attract the resources I need. It is true that some people are called to a double role—working simultaneously as a minister of the Gospel and a professional in the business world. If that is your path, you must have the wisdom to know how to act at the altar and what strategy to use in the corporate office. Settle your identity today. Define your boundaries—know what to accept and exactly what to refuse. When who you are is finally anchored, you will be amazed by how naturally everything else falls into place.

THE FOUR LEVELS OF RELATIONSHIP

The Three Directions of Leadership

In his book *The 360-Degree Leader*, John C. Maxwell identifies three essential levels of relationships that every leader must navigate. To be truly effective, you must know how to lead in three directions: up, across, and down.

- **Leading Up:** This is how you respect, support, and relate to your superiors, mentors, and those in authority over you.
- **Leading Across:** This is how you collaborate, communicate, and build strong partnerships with your peers and equals.
- **Leading Down:** This is how you guide, mentor, and care for those who look to you for leadership and serve under your care.

Honoring Those Above You

Within your relationships, there are three distinct groups of people positioned above you:

- **Your Parents:** Both your spiritual parents and your biological parents.
- **Your Leaders:** Anyone placed in authority over you with the responsibility to supervise you, give you assignments, and guide you.
- **The Elders:** Individuals who may not be your direct leaders, but who have the maturity of years and have walked ahead of you in life.

The critical question is: **how do you effectively build relationships with these three groups?** While there are many ways to connect, there is one universal, foundational rule that unlocks all of them: you must show them true honor. You must intentionally choose to treat your leaders, your elders, and your parents with deep respect.

Overcoming the Trap of Familiarity

This is particularly important when dealing with your own household. You must show special honor to your biological parents. It is easy to lose respect for them simply because you see their everyday human flaws, but you must guard your heart against this attitude. Distance yourself from that kind of casual disrespect. Recognize and respect the parents God used to bring you into this world, and always maintain a standard of honor.

Respecting Those Around You

In your everyday life, your relationships generally fall into three main groups: your friends, your associates, and your colleagues (your co-workers and peers). The master key to building healthy relationships with these three groups is **mutual respect**. Mutual respect means there is a healthy give-and-take:

you intentionally treat others with dignity, and they extend that same standard of dignity back to you.

The Importance of Boundaries with Friends

Friends, in particular, must understand that respect is a two-way street. To keep your friendships strong, keep these principles in mind:

- **Watch Your Words:** Never speak to your friends in an embarrassing, condescending, or undermining way.
- **Keep a Filter:** Avoid becoming careless in your communication. People might tolerate a lack of manners for a short season, but eventually, they will reach a breaking point and the relationship will fall apart.

Every human being has a natural desire to be respected. In these relationships, respect doesn't mean you have to use formal titles like "**sir**" or "**ma'am**." True respect is the genuine value and high regard you hold in your heart for another person. Treat those in your circle with real care, and let true honor shine through in every conversation.

Leading Those Under Your Care

Within your leadership, there are two distinct groups of people positioned below you: **your followers and your subordinates (your juniors)**. It is important to notice the difference between the two: **a person can work under you without necessarily being your follower**. They might not share your personal vision; instead, they are simply connected to you because of a job description or an organizational structure. Just because someone is junior to you in rank does not automatically mean

they are a devoted follower of your life. The foundational key to managing these relationships well is **fair treatment**. You must intentionally choose to treat everyone with **equity and fairness**.

How to Treat Those Under Your Leadership

To be an effective and respected leader, practice these daily habits:

- **Watch Your Words:** Be exceptionally careful about the language you use around them. Your words carry weight and can deeply wound their feelings. Never speak to them carelessly; instead, deliberately address them with dignity.
- **Remove Fear:** Refuse to use fear, shouting, or toxic intimidation to get results. Never place them under unnecessary pressure or vent your personal frustrations and anger onto them.
- **Value Their Worth:** Never weaponize your position to crush someone's self-esteem or personal importance. Ensure that people feel genuinely valued and significant whenever they are around you.

Always treat those under you fairly, remembering that life can change quickly. A junior employee today could easily become a key decision-maker in your future tomorrow. Be the kind of leader who models unwavering fairness.

Discerning Your Connections: Family and Strangers

Beyond your everyday leaders, peers, and those under your care, there is a vital fourth level of relationship: **your interactions with extended family—like cousins, nieces, nephews, and uncles—and complete strangers**. You must stay alert to the

fact that you will continuously cross paths with strangers whom God has sent to open massive doors of opportunity, launching you into the next great season of your life.

The Role of Discernment

To build and protect your relationships with both family and strangers, you need deep discernment. Think of discernment as your internal tracking system. It is the ability to accurately understand what a person truly needs from you and how you should respond to them.

When you meet someone, your discernment should help you sense the true nature of their character and intentions. You must learn to evaluate people carefully. You can capture this insight through:

- 4. Refine Your Talents:** Develop your gifts through continuous practice and improvement.

When you commit to these steps, you won't have to chase connections—they will come to you. Visionaries and leaders will travel any distance to learn from you. People and organizations will aggressively seek out your products and services the moment they see the quality of your work. Stop chasing the crowd. Start bearing fruit, and the crowd will naturally follow you.

The Parable of the Mango Tree

To understand how this works, consider a large mango tree growing deep inside a private compound. During the seasons when the mangoes are green, sour, and unripe, the tree is completely left alone. No one comes near it, and no one tries to climb its branches or harvest its yield. However, the moment

those mangoes ripen into a golden, sweet harvest, everything changes. People of all kinds—including total strangers—gather around the compound, looking for a way to pick the fruit.

The Power of a Stationary Harvest

Notice the behavior of the tree: **it never uproots itself to carry its harvest to the consumer.** The mango tree stays perfectly still. It does not deliver fruit to your living room, nor does it send out formal invitations to the neighborhood. The simple presence of ripe fruit on the branch naturally draws a crowd. In the same way, when you step into your true potential, achieve great results, and master your field, you won't need a massive advertising campaign to attract people. The quality of your work will act as a natural invitation, and people will surely find their way to you.

The Law of the System: The Power of Routine

Every visionary must master a profound principle: for everything you want to achieve in this life, there is a specific routine you must practice to secure it. This applies even beyond prayer. In fact, for everything you ask for in prayer, there is still a vital routine you must implement after you say “**amen.**” Routine is simply the habit of taking consistent action. It is the practical definition of true diligence—the discipline to show up and do the work faithfully, even when you don't feel like it.

Turning Goals into Reality

The main reason many people fail to see real progress in their lives is their refusal to commit to a daily routine. Building a routine requires radical intentionality; it cannot be based on casual wishes. If you have big goals but lack the daily routines

to match them, your goals are nothing more than illusions. To build an effective, unbreakable routine, you must anchor your habits upon two non-negotiable pillars:

1. **Assign a Dedicated Place:** Choose a specific physical location where your task will happen.

If you want to build a vibrant, consistent prayer life, you must build a routine around your quiet time. For a believer, prayer should never be treated casually or approached with a lazy attitude. This isn't about falling into a rigid religious ritual; it is about setting a specific place and a precise time to meet and commune with God every single day. Of course, you don't have to limit your prayers to that designated hour alone. You can and should pray during your commute, your moments of leisure, and whenever your mind is free. Make it a habit to fire up your prayer altar the moment you wake up each morning.

Integrity in the Workplace

At the same time, keep your spiritual life disciplined and orderly. Do not spend time praying at work during hours when you are being paid to do your job. Instead, use your official breaks for prayer. Be an ambassador of excellence who handles professional responsibilities with absolute integrity. Never let a

Protection Through Structure

Prayer grows in power the moment you protect it with a system. You build that system by strictly maintaining your fixed place and your fixed time. The exact same principle applies to reading the Word of God. You must have a structured layout—a routine that deliberately safeguards your spiritual growth.

Field-Specific Routines for Global Breakthrough

If you are ready to see a breakthrough in your career, industry, or business, there are specific routines you must practice every single week.

- **For the Ministry Leader:** Never let a week pass without studying fresh revelation and leadership insights. This requires a steady routine of deep reading and listening to seasoned voices.
- **For the Marketplace Professional:** Maintain a regular habit of reading current business literature, studying successful companies, and having intentional, strategic conversations with experts in your field.

Plan Your Growth

Do not leave these growth opportunities to chance. Schedule the exact times you plan to meet with a mentor, read a specific book, review your metrics, or attend training courses. When you practice these routines consistently, high-level results will flow naturally out of your actions. Identify the routines your current calling requires, and lock them into your calendar.

Every massive skyscraper you see began as a single block. The builders didn't create a masterpiece in a day; they simply stayed consistent, laying block after block until it was finished. You will be amazed by the giant leaps that happen in your life the moment you commit to these small, daily tasks. Set your place, lock in your time, and execute. Build a solid routine today, and watch your life step smoothly into the future God has planned for you.

THE PARABLE OF THE PENCIL

Jesus the Master Communicator

Jesus Christ was the ultimate master communicator, and His primary way of reaching people was through beautifully crafted parables. Parables are essentially prophetic stories. They are creative illustrations used by a speaker—not necessarily to record a historical event, but to show the mind of God to the listener. A parable wraps a profound, eternal message in an accessible, everyday package. About a decade ago, I read a book containing a specific parable that has never left me. I have held onto this illustration because it continually guides my decisions, shapes my perspective, and clarifies my judgment whenever I face critical situations.

Proving the Blueprint: The Parable of the Pencil

Before placing the pencil into its box, the pencil maker took it aside and shared five key truths it needed to know to fulfill its purpose. As I share these five principles with you, I invite you to reflect on your own life through the lens of this pencil.

1. You Must Allow Yourself to Be Held by a Master Hand

The Principle of Submission

A pencil has the raw potential to sketch a beautiful car, design a mansion, draw a portrait, or map out the entire world. It can be used for intricate shading, art, and brilliant writing. Yet, despite this massive internal capability, the pencil cannot make a single stroke on its own. It requires a hand to hold it. This is where many people fail in life. They carry immense potential, but they refuse to submit to a spiritual or institutional hand that can guide, instruct, and direct them. They want to create success on their own terms, completely unwilling to yield to authority. Because of this pride, their raw talent goes to waste. They remain stuck simply because they refuse to be flexible.

The Power of Guidance

If you study the biography of any truly great leader, you will discover that at the start of their journey, they submitted to a voice that told them exactly what to do. Many young people mistakenly believe that God will always bypass human structures to speak to them directly. As a result, they resist mentorship and run from guidance. When you say, “***I am directly in the hand of God,***” remember that God is a Spirit. When He wants to accomplish an earthly task, He uses human beings. You must allow God to hold you through the tool of a proven mentor. If you can humble yourself, submit to authority, and follow instructions faithfully, you will be amazed by your achievements. True greatness shows up when you allow yourself to be held accountable.

2. You Will Endure Painful Sharpening from Time to Time

The Principle of Processing

To sharpen a dull pencil, a craftsman doesn’t use soft wood; he uses a sharp, ruthless blade. When a pencil is used heavily for

drawing and writing, its tip wears down, and its true potential gets hidden beneath the surface. The blade must cut away the outer layers of wood so the core can be exposed again. When you face seasons of severe pressure and adversity, you must recognize that you are going through a divine sharpening process. The friction is intensely painful, and the cutting is uncomfortable. Yet, it is the only way God draws out the incredible potential hidden deep within you. Your crisis is not an assassination attempt; it is a painful sharpening designed to reveal your true capacity.

3. You Are Equipped to Correct Your Mistakes

The Principle of Redemption

Every well-designed pencil is fitted with an eraser. This means that built directly into your life is a way to wipe away the errors of your past. You must identify what your eraser represents. For one person, the eraser is sincere repentance; for another, it is humility, a teachable spirit, or an honest confession. For others, it is a commitment to learning and training so they don't repeat yesterday's failures. There is a tool for starting over inside you capable of canceling your mistakes—find it and use it.

4. The Most Important Part of You Will Always Be What Is Inside

The Principle of Core Substance

The most valuable part of your identity is never your outward appearance, your clothes, or the status symbols you show to the public. True treasure is your internal character. If the world stripped away everything you have on the outside today, what would be left inside your spirit? Never forget that the wealth within you has the power to rebuild whatever you lack on the

outside. A pencil may be beautifully decorated with golden paint, but its hidden core remains its only true asset. Guard your inner life above all else.

5. On Every Surface You Touch, You Must Leave a Lasting Mark
The Principle of Legacy

No matter the texture of the paper or how harsh the environment, a pencil's only job is to keep writing. In the same way, no matter what conditions you face, you must refuse to stay silent. Every single person who crosses your path should leave your presence with a lasting impression stamped upon their life. You must become a force for permanent impact. Commit to these five laws of growth and submission, and you will be amazed at how powerfully your life will make history.

THE LAW OF SEQUENCE

Understanding Divine Order: The Threefold Pattern of Abraham

The life of Abraham serves as a perfect example of divine order. In Genesis 12:1–2, Scripture declares: “Now the Lord had said to Abram: ‘Get out of your country, from your family and from your father’s house, to a land that I will show you. I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing.’” These foundational verses reveal a unique blueprint. While given specifically to Abraham, it applies to every believer trying to navigate their destiny. Within this promise, the Lord outlines three distinct dimensions that make up the pattern of divine order. Remarkably, at the exact moment the Lord spoke these words, the man’s name was still Abram. The name change to Abraham had not yet happened. God was speaking to his potential while he was still in his raw state. Today, these same three promises are at work in the lives of everyone moving toward their God-given destiny.

The Three Dimensions of the Divine Blueprint

1. Revelation: God Will Show You

At the very beginning of your journey, God's main goal is to give you sight. Before He ever asks you to move, He provides clarity. God must show you your future—the specific path He has mapped out for your life. He reveals the scope of your calling, the business He wants you to build, the ministry you belong to, and the unique role you are meant to play in this world.

The Lord always provides internal insight before He begins the practical process of making it real. God will not build anything in your life until He has first placed it in your vision. He expects you to see the blueprint on the inside before you take a single step forward.

2. Processing: God Will Make You

The “*making*” phase is what we call the process. God must break, mold, and refine you until your character is strong enough to handle what He showed you in the first stage. He must change you from the inside out so you can safely become the person you were born to be. Being shaped by God is often the most critical—yet painful—part of life. To move from seeing the vision to actually living it, you must go through this transformation. Once God gives you the blueprint, you must prepare your heart to handle the training, teaching, and corrections that follow. During this time, the Lord will intentionally put you in demanding environments. He uses these challenging opportunities to test your strength and ensure you are truly ready to possess the future He promised you.

3. Manifestation: God Will Bless You

The moment your training is complete, the Lord will bring the blessing into your life. You must have the spiritual wisdom to recognize which of these three stages you are currently in. It is

a mistake to demand the blessing before your making process is finished. You must patiently trust the Lord, allowing Him to build the inner strength you need to safely handle the weight of what He showed you.

Reviewing Your Current Season

Where do you stand today in God's order? Is the Lord currently showing you, making you, or blessing you? You cannot afford to live blindly; you must recognize exactly where you are in your spiritual journey. Each phase demands a completely different approach from you:

A Final Decree

God will show you, He will make you, and He will bless you. You cannot bypass this sequence. Submit to His order, become everything He created you to be, and step into everything He has reserved for your future.

THE TRANSFERENCE OF GOD'S WORD AND THE HUMAN SPIRIT

The Law of Impartation: Sound, Spirit, and Substance

One of the greatest supernatural benefits of listening to and reading the teachings of your spiritual leader is the transference of spirits. The messages and writings of an anointed leader carry more than just information; they act as a pipeline that imparts the exact grace, drive, and spiritual mantle resting on that leader directly into your spirit. God designed the human experience so that deep spiritual dimensions are transferred through the power of words. In John 6:63, Jesus outlines this law: ***“It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.”*** In this context, the word spirit does not just refer to the Holy Spirit as a person; it describes an active spiritual force. Words are literal vehicles of power. To listen to an anointed voice is to open your heart to receive real, spiritual strength into your inner self.

Inner Strength for Outer Battles

Human life is shaped by both internal and external forces. The

specific strength of the force operating inside your spirit dictates your ability to resist and defeat the pressures of the dark world around you. Consider the experience of the Prophet Ezekiel: ***“Then the Spirit entered me when He spoke to me, and set me on my feet; and I heard Him who spoke to me”*** (Ezekiel 2:2). The moment the voice of God reached the prophet’s ears, an internal spiritual force entered him and physically positioned him for his assignment. This establishes a kingdom principle: when the Word enters, the Spirit enters. Every time you intentionally receive a word from your spiritual leader, you are taking in a specific spiritual force. To the natural mind, a teacher of the Word is merely speaking human language. But as a believer trained in discernment, you recognize that they are speaking raw spirit and life into your destiny. True spiritual leaders do not speak to entertain human intellect—they release a force that empowers your inner man.

The Anatomy of the Inner Man

To fully understand Ezekiel 2:2, we must look at what the word ***“me”*** means in that text: ***“Then the Spirit entered me...”*** In the language of heaven, that ***“me”*** represents the human spirit. Man does not merely have a spirit; man is a spirit. Therefore, when an anointed word is spoken, an external spiritual force enters your human spirit. According to the parables of Christ, the Word of God functions like a living seed sown into the soil of the human heart. Because that seed is filled with the Spirit, you will only ever be as strong as the scriptural truths anchored inside your soul. Look at the Apostle Paul’s advice to Timothy: ***“For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind”*** (2 Timothy 1:7). Once again, the word spirit here describes an active force. God did not create you to

hold onto the force of fear. Instead, He has filled you with the forces of love, power, and mental clarity. The spirit of fear is an opposing force designed to paralyze your heart. The only way to uproot it is to take in a superior word that brings absolute boldness.

Overcoming the Fear of Death: A Personal Account

I remember a season in my journey when a heavy, suffocating fear of dying young attacked my mind. Instead of panicking, I dug deep into the scriptures hidden in my heart, anchoring my soul on a specific promise: ***“No evil shall befall you, nor shall any plague come near your dwelling.”*** I meditated on that text until it became a living reality inside me. My strategy was simple: I opened my mouth and spoke the Word, declaring continuously, ***“No evil shall befall me!”*** A few weeks later, that same dark fear tried to return. Immediately, the Holy Spirit brought Psalm 118:17 alive in my heart: ***“I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the Lord.”*** ***The moment that scripture flashed in my mind, I stood my ground and declared, “I cannot die!”*** When the enemy made a final, desperate attempt to paralyze my mind with fear, the Lord gave me an even deeper insight through Psalm 72:15: “And he shall live; and to him shall be given of the gold of Sheba...” I shifted my declaration to a direct command: ***“I shall live!”*** The power of this testimony applies to everyone. If anyone wrestling with the terrifying spirit of death comes into my presence and hears these scriptures, they will experience the exact same breakthrough the moment they believe. These verses are no longer just black ink on white paper—they have become a living, burning force inside me. And when those words are spoken, every opposing spiritual force must bow down.

Shift Your Prayer Strategy

There was another season when a severe spiritual attack was launched against my life. I couldn't sleep at all. Whenever I closed my eyes, even for a moment, I was terrorized by vivid nightmares. The attack was so intense that it began to ruin my daily focus. Because of my spiritual discernment, I knew right away that this was not a medical crisis—it was a coordinated spiritual assault. At first, I began to cry out to God in prayer, asking Him to deliver me from these unseen enemies. But while I was praying one day, the Holy Spirit suddenly made Psalm 118:10–12 explode like light inside me: “All nations surrounded me, but in the name of the Lord I will destroy them. They surrounded me, yes, they surrounded me; but in the name of the Lord I will destroy them. They surrounded me like bees; they were quenched like a fire of thorns; for in the name of the Lord I will destroy them.” The moment that scripture became real to me, my entire approach changed. The power of that word showed me to stop asking God to do what He had already empowered me to do. The text revealed that God was waiting for me to use His name to defeat the forces surrounding my life. I immediately changed my prayer focus. I stood up and commanded: ***“Every spiritual force affecting my sleep and targeting my health, be destroyed right now in the name of Jesus!”*** The takeaway is absolute: **the moment a scripture comes alive inside your spirit, a supernatural force is activated within you. You instantly become as strong as the verse you stand upon.**

The Spiritual Defiance Protocol

Submit to God —————▶ Absorb the Revelation —————▶ Enforce the Name

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The Devil Flees **Actively Resist the Enemy**

Enforcing the Victory

Ephesians 4:27 tells us: “***nor give place to the devil.***” You must refuse to give the enemy an inch of territory in your body, your finances, your family, your career, or your ministry. James 4:7 provides the two-step formula for absolute victory: “Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.” When you truly understand the Scriptures, you will no longer waste time asking God to handle a defeated enemy. Guided by divine revelation, you will take the sword of the Spirit and enforce the victory yourself.

Enforcing the Defeat of the Enemy

You must be completely sure of this reality: **the devil flees the moment you resist him with Scripture.** To resist means to push back, push away, and push out. When you push back against the enemy, you don’t do it in your own human strength; you do it under the absolute authority of God’s Word. You rebuke the devil in the name of the Lord, actively confronting every spiritual trap set against your life. The truths and testimonies in these pages are not just information—they are the very forces alive inside my own spirit. By reading this message, those same forces are being passed on to you. When the outer force of fear attacks, it must run into a greater, pre-existing inner force within your soul. When the spirit of death arrives and finds your heart completely anchored on an unshakeable scriptural promise, you become an unstoppable force in that area of your life. Therefore, fix this law in your heart: **whatever cannot defeat the Word of God inside you cannot defeat you.**

The Power of Spiritual Collision

Every time you listen to your spiritual leader or immerse yourself in their writings, you are either taking in a new spiritual force or activating one that is already resting inside you. You must understand that the power of God's Word is actively filling your inner self. The next time a negative word or an evil report tries to enter your heart to cause panic, your immediate response must be to speak out the spiritual force within you. Open your mouth and declare the Word.

God did not reveal His Word to you just to increase your knowledge, nor did He connect you to your leader just to satisfy your curiosity. God gives you access to an anointed voice so that you can catch the spirit behind the voice and release that same power through your own words. Sometimes, you must intentionally allow an attacking spirit to collide with the inner strength of your revelation. If spirits of torment, fear, death, failure, depression, or confusion attack your environment, let them crash head-on into the living Word anchored in your soul. Let external circumstances collide with your faith. Tough situations can create a heavy atmosphere, but the Word of God is the ultimate power. Build your entire life, hope, and expectations around the Scriptures.

The Law of Spiritual Alignment: Finding Your Guide

Consider the Apostle Paul's second letter to the Corinthian church: "I urged Titus, and sent our brother with him. Did Titus take advantage of you? Did we not walk in the same spirit? Did we not walk in the same steps?" (2 Corinthians 12:18) The word **spirit** in this text does not refer directly to the person of the Holy Spirit. Instead, it describes the specific driving force, mindset, and grace that motivated the Apostle Paul. Titus captured this

exact force. He read the letters Paul wrote, spent time in his presence, and listened to him speak. As a result, the same spirit operating in Paul began to guide Titus. This brings us to a foundational truth: every time you listen to your spiritual leader, you are taking in their spirit. Therefore, everything begins with your ability to recognize that specific individual. Ask yourself this direct question: **Who is your spiritual leader (assigned Man of God)?**

The Law of Spiritual Alignment

ALL BELIEVERS —————▶ **Positioned as Sons of God**

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THE FIVEFOLD —————▶ **Called as Ministers & Servants**

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YOUR MAN OF GOD —————▶ **Divinely Assigned Pointer to Your Destiny**

While all believers are children of God, He has set apart specific ministers to nurture, equip, and mature the Church. Among these leaders, God has uniquely assigned specific individuals to act as a guide for your destiny. God will not link you to every minister on earth; He will strategically align you with your specific leader.

- **Every Titus must have a Paul.**
- **Every Timothy must have a Paul.**
- **Every Mark must have a Barnabas or a Peter.**

Discerning Your Assigned Voice

The main reason many believers drift aimlessly from one ministry to another is that they have failed to recognize their assigned leader (Man of God). You need spiritual sight to know whom God has authorized you to follow. The moment you identify your leader, that is the voice you must consistently learn from. One of the clearest signs of this divine connection is that God will consistently place the exact words you need for your current season on that leader's lips. When they speak, something strikes a deep chord within your heart. There will be an undeniable alignment in your thoughts, insights, and actions. Deep spiritual qualities will stir within you the moment you listen to your appointed leader. Scripture confirms this pattern in the household of Cornelius: "While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word" (Acts 10:44). A real spiritual force is always transmitted when you listen to the person God has chosen for you to hear. Remember, before Peter ever arrived at that house, an angel explicitly told Cornelius to send specifically for Peter—not John, and not any other apostle. You cannot experience the full weight of a spiritual impartation if you do not value the specific person God has chosen to oversee your life. This does not mean you can never listen to other ministers of the gospel. However, constantly drifting between different voices will cause spiritual confusion. You must have a primary, consistent source—a voice you listen to habitually throughout the seasons of your life, establishing a connection that stands firm for the long haul.

The Mantle is the Spirit

There is a precise word in your assigned leader for every season of your life. Every believer and minister must learn this principle early. Your assigned leader will almost always carry

a distinct prophetic or apostolic mantle, because this is how God has ordered the leadership of the Church. Many people are misled because they chase after popularity, crowds, and trends rather than seeking the specific path assigned to them. If I know whose voice you are consistently listening to, I can easily tell what kind of spirit you will carry. We see this pattern established in Numbers 11:16–17: “So the Lord said to Moses: ‘Gather to Me seventy men of the elders of Israel... I will take of the Spirit that is upon you and will put the same upon them; and they shall bear the burden of the people with you...’” What those seventy elders were unable to accomplish on their own, they did effortlessly the moment the spirit resting on Moses was placed upon them. It was a literal transference of spiritual capacity.

The Power of a Shared Spirit

Similarly, the Prophet Ezekiel records: “So I prophesied as He commanded me, and breath came into them, and they lived, and stood upon their feet, an exceedingly great army” (Ezekiel 37:10). The breath that entered that valley was a powerful spiritual force. A scattered valley of dry bones rose and transformed into a massive army the moment anointed words were spoken over them. There is an incredible power available when you consistently listen to the teachings of your leader (Man of God). Constant exposure causes that same spirit to fill your life. You are instantly empowered to achieve breakthroughs you could never do before, think with a level of wisdom you have never possessed, and move with unstoppable spiritual momentum. When the sons of the prophets looked at Elisha, they observed: “The spirit of Elijah rests on Elisha.” And they came to meet him, and bowed to the ground before him (2 Kings 2:15). If you desire to carry the spiritual power of a specific

mantle, the key is simple: **focus your ears on that voice**. The spirit operating in that leader's life will inevitably rub off on you. You will naturally begin to think the way they think, discern the way they discern, and fulfill your purpose with the exact same power. This is why the angel declared of John the Baptist: "He will also go before Him in the spirit and power of Elijah..." (Luke 1:17). The identical force that powered Elijah was what operated within John. In the Kingdom, when we speak of a leader's (Man of God) mantle, we are speaking directly about the ***transference of the Spirit***.

The Two Pathways of Impartation

There are two distinct, divinely chosen paths through which a believer can receive the spirit and mantle of a leader:

- **The Pathway of Proximity and Learning:** This is when you intentionally follow a leader by serving them, honoring their ministry, and consistently listening to their teachings.
- **The Pathway of Isolation:** This is when God bypasses human closeness and intentionally places you in a wilderness season to shape you independently.

When you follow an anointed leader and consistently take in their words, the exact spiritual force driving that person smoothly enters your heart. On the other hand, when God places you in isolation, He changes you from the inside out. As you fast and pray during these quiet seasons, the mantle heavily descends upon your life. Consider the example of John the Baptist. He never had the chance to meet Elijah in person. Instead, he lived in the rugged wilderness of Judea. While the spirits of Moses, Paul, and Elijah often rested on others through

a direct, hands-on connection, John's lack of physical closeness did not stop him from carrying the raw spirit and power of Elijah. He carried that mantle because he was willing to fully endure the isolated training God chose for him.

The Dynamics of Spiritual Impartation

You must understand that you do not carry the Holy Spirit alone; there is a clear spiritual law that allows you to carry the spiritual grace and mindset of an anointed leader. The primary way to receive this is simply by **listening**. When you consistently listen to your leader, the exact spiritual force driving their life expands into yours. You will suddenly find yourself operating with that same boldness, precision, and courage. Scripture reveals that spiritual dimensions are entirely transferable and scalable:

- **The Law of Distribution:** The spirit of one person can be multiplied and shared among many. For example, seventy elders simultaneously carried the exact spirit that rested upon Moses (Numbers 11:25).
- **The Law of Amplification:** One person can carry a double portion of another person's spirit. Elisha successfully caught and operated in twice the power of Elijah (2 Kings 2:9).
- **The Law of Convergence:** A single individual can carry the combined spiritual graces of multiple leaders. This rare connection is at work today in the lives of deeply matured spiritual leaders.

An Apostolic Charge to the Reader

Do not take the books or spoken teachings of your leader (Man

of God) lightly. Make it a priority to read the books they have written and set aside time to listen to their audio messages regularly. Make a firm decision to keep your heart positioned under the flow of their words. As you do, the invisible spiritual strength that brings them victory will be poured directly into your life.

You have now journeyed through nineteen distinct dimen-

sions of divine insight, and if you have read with an open heart, you are no longer the same person who picked up this book. You now understand that the process always precedes the promotion, that not every gift deserves your hand, and that your identity must be settled long before your assignment can be fruitful. And may every storm you encounter from this day forward be understood for what it truly is—not an assassination attempt, but a path being cleared for the magnificent future God has already prepared for you. This is only Volume One. There is more insight ahead, and I trust that what you have received here has positioned you to receive even more. Until then, walk in the light of what you now know, and watch your life write a history that glorifies the One who authored it.
